- Properties located on the marsh are required to contact the Department of Natural Resources for a survey.
- Each fence application is reviewed based on the property shape and intended use. Prior approvals in the neighborhood are not material to current requests. The covenants state that fences or screens may be used to enclose service areas, patios, swimming pools, or other areas requiring privacy.
- If your application is approved by the ARB, please contact Chatham County to receive instructions on obtaining a fence permit. Lanier will need to have a copy of the permit on file before final gate access approval will be granted.

I understand the terms of this application and understand that I may need approval from various entities before I can proceed with a fence installation. Failure to comply may result in the removal of amenity use and may be subject to legal recourse by the Long Point Homeowners Association.
